



## AAAS BOOK AWARDS Nomination Guidelines

The Association for Asian American Studies (AAAS) is currently accepting nominations for the AAAS Annual Book Awards. The Association offers awards for titles of merit published in 2009. Categories include: **Social Science, Literary Studies, Cultural Studies, History, Engaged Scholarship, and Poetry/Prose.** The category of **Engaged Scholarship** also includes a separate sub-category for the field of **Psychology.** This category is open to various kinds of publications and is not restricted to book publications.

The Award recipients receive acknowledgement from the Association for Asian American Studies Executive Board and general membership. Award presentation will be held at our 2011 annual meeting (April 2011 in New Orleans, LA – Sheraton New Orleans Hotel). The Committee Chair and/or the President will honor the recipient with an etched plaque commemorating the author/s and work. Award winners will also be announced in the AAAS quarterly newsletter and on the AAAS website.

The appropriate Book Award Committee will review titles in consideration for the 2009 awards. Each Committee is selected by the Executive Board of the Association for Asian American Studies and is composed of three members who specialize in Social Science, Literary Studies, Cultural Studies, History, Engaged Scholarship, and Poetry/Prose.

2. Ship five (5) copies of the nominated title, along with your specification for title category, to the address below:

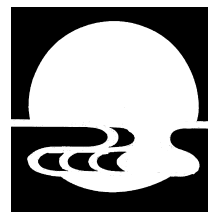

Decisions from the Book Award Committees will be made in December 2010. The Secretariat will notify Award recipients and publishers by January 2011. The award will be presented to the author/s at the 2011 Annual Meeting of the Association for Asian American Studies in New Orleans, Louisiana.

Books published in 2010 will be awarded at our 2012 conference (Washington, DC).
