The Association for Asian American Studies (AAAS) is currently accepting nominations for the AAAS Annual Book Awards. The Association offers awards for titles of merit published in 2010. Categories include: **Social Science, Literary Studies, Cultural Studies, History, and Poetry/Prose.**

The Award recipients receive acknowledgement from the Association for Asian American Studies Executive Board and general membership. Award presentation will be held at our 2012 annual meeting (April 2012 in Washington D.C.). The Committee Chair and/or the President will honor the recipient with an etched plaque commemorating the author/s and work. Award winners will also be announced through the AAAS listserv and on the AAAS website.

The appropriate Book Award Committee will review titles in consideration for the 2010 awards. Each Committee is selected by the Executive Board of the Association for Asian American Studies and is composed of three members who specialize in Social Science, Literary Studies, Cultural Studies, History, and Poetry/Prose.

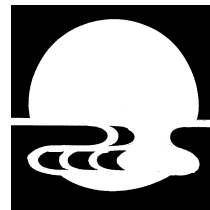
